The program includes a series of accredited workshops to provide a minimum standard plus an option to complete additional workshops to achieve a Certificate II in Engineering Pathways (MEM20413).

Program options will be either:

In addition to the formal learning component, additional requirements to support completion of your program include:

- completion of a log book to capture and record your learning journey
- being matched with a mentor to support your transition to becoming classroom confident.
- You will require approval from your principal to participate in this program as release time is required.
- Your school will be provided with Teacher Relief Scheme (TRS) funding via a SABA payment to support your release.
